

ROCKY CREEK HUT

Rocky Creek Hut is located in Kuitpo Forest 45 minutes drive from Adelaide. Set amongst old growth pine and eucalypt plantations Rocky Creek Hut is suitable for a wide range of groups including families, schools, scouts and other events. The area is available for overnight camping or day use.

Location

From the Forest Information Centre travel to Meadows then along Battunga Road towards Echunga for 4.3 km. Turn Left onto Razorback Road and travel for 2.4km. The entrance gates are on the left.

Facilities

- The Hut is a one room stone cottage that sleeps up to eight people on two wooden platforms. For larger groups there is room surrounding the hut for tents.
- Inside are a slow combustion wood heater, sink and small food preparation area.
- Outside are a veranda, two picnic tables, a fire pit, rainwater tanks (not suitable for drinking) and a pit toilet.
- Solar lighting inside and outside.
- You will need to bring your own bedding, cooking and eating utensils.

Bookings

- Overnight bookings are available from the 1st April – 30th November except on Total Fire Ban Day.
- Day bookings are available all year round except on Total Fire Ban days.

Hut Fees

Hut fees are to be paid in full within 2 weeks of making your booking at the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre, or alternatively cheques can be made out to **ForestrySA** and posted to the address below.

Terms and Conditions of Use

<u>Arrival Time</u>	Overnight use: 2.00pm Day use: 10.30am
<u>Vehicles</u>	The entrance gate must be kept locked. Please park in the designated areas. You are not permitted to drive in the forest.
<u>Access Into Hut</u>	Contact the Forest Information Centre the day before your arrival to obtain the combination lock number.
<u>Disturbance</u>	The use of generators is not permitted. Please consider other forest users and keep noise levels down.
<u>Fires</u>	Fires are permitted from 1 st May to 31 st October. You may collect dead fallen timber from the adjoining pine plantation. It is an offence to cut any standing timber. Solid fuel fires prohibited from 1st November to 1st May All fires must be fully extinguished before departure.
<u>Gas Appliances</u>	The use of gas appliances is permitted from 1 st April to 30 th November.
<u>Cleaning</u>	Please leave the hut, toilet and grounds clean and tidy. All rubbish to be removed from the site.
<u>Departure Time</u>	Overnight users: 10.00am Day users: Before sunset

JACK'S PADDOCK

Jack's Paddock is an exclusive use campground located in Kuitpo Forest 45 minutes drive from Adelaide. Set in eleven hectares of mixed eucalypt woodland Jack's Paddock is suitable for a wide range of groups including families, schools, scouts, horse riders and other events. The area is available for overnight camping or day use.

Location

Jacks Paddock is located in Kuitpo Forest 2.5km south of the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre along Brookman Road.

Facilities

- The hut is a two-roomed wooden structure with open doorway. It has an open fire place and room for sleeping, storage and food preparation.
- Outside there are two picnic tables, a fire pit, rainwater tanks (not suitable for drinking) and a pit toilet.
- Solar lighting inside and in front of the hut.
- Eight individual horse yards suitable for holding horses overnight.

Bookings

- Overnight bookings are available from the 1st April – 30th November except on Total Fire Ban Days.
- Day bookings are available all year round except on Total Fire Ban days.

Hut Fees

Hut fees are to be paid in full within 2 weeks of making your booking at the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre, or alternatively cheques can be made out to **ForestrySA** and posted to the address below.

<u>Vehicles</u>	Keep the entrance gate locked. Please park in the designated areas. You are not permitted to drive in the forest.
<u>Access Into Hut</u>	Contact the Forest Information Centre the day before your arrival to obtain the combination lock number.
<u>Disturbance</u>	The use of generators is not permitted. Please consider other forest users and keep noise levels down.
<u>Fires</u>	Fires are permitted from 1 st May to 31 st October. You may collect dead fallen timber from the adjoining pine plantation. It is an offence to cut any standing timber. Solid fuel fires prohibited from 1st November to 1st May All fires must be fully extinguished before departure.
<u>Gas Appliances</u>	The use of gas appliances is permitted from 1 st April to 30 th November.
<u>Cleaning</u>	Please leave the hut, toilet and grounds clean and tidy. All rubbish to be removed from the site.
<u>Departure Time</u>	Overnight users: 10.00am Day users: Before sunset
